We invite you to participate in the 6th Annual Berg/Seeger Track and Field Classic, hosted by the Minnesota State Academy for the Deaf. Scheduled for April 12-13, 2013 in Faribault, MN, the Berg/Seeger Track and Field Classic aims to promote interest in track and field among Deaf and hard of hearing high school athletes. With over 200 participants expected, this event will be a most memorable one.

The classic will be held at Bruce Smith Track and Field (Alexander Park). Faribault High School has generously agreed to let us use their track and field facilities. Their track and field facilities are one of the best in southeast Minnesota. It has 9 lanes, 2-colored alternate lanes, two jumping pits, two shot put areas and one discus area, and an electronic scoreboard. Athletes from around the nation will have the opportunity to stay at one of the most beautiful campus in the nation, at MSAD. The Hilltopper Athletic Booster Club will provide meals. With preliminaries and some events taking place on Friday evening starting at 6pm, meals will begin with dinner on Friday. Each school will be responsible for supervision of its teams at all times. If you plan to fly in – the nearest airport is the Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport (MSP).
