The Kentucky School for the Deaf is proud to announce the 7th Annual Berg/Seeger Track & Field Classic on April 12, 2014 at Danville Admiral Stadium. We are very much honored to host this special event. This classic is open to all Deaf HS athletes attending schools for the Deaf and mainstreamed schools in the United States. The purpose for this classic is to promote interest in track and field among Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing high school athletes.

KSD will provide meals, hospitality rooms, housing and track/field facilities usage. All Meals will be covered during your stay in KY. Meals will start with dinner on Friday, April 11th. Your school will be responsible for supervision of your teams in the residence halls and during the meet. (Schools are encouraged to fly into Blue Grass Airport – Lexington, KY. Transportation will be provided to and from Blue Grass Airport only. Should your school fly into Louisville, you will need to prepare transportation. Details on cost per person will be forthcoming soon).

USA Deaf Track & Field (USADTF) will also use this event as an opportunity to give the students exposure to events in the future for USA Deaf athletes, such as the World Deaf Track & Field Championships and Summer Deaflympics. Awards for the Berg-Seeger will be presented to top three finishers as well as top three teams in both boys and girls groups. Top athletes award will be voted and honored for Best Track, Best Field, and All-Around.
